

SOUTH CAROLINA (3-2, 2-2 SEC) vs. MISSOURI (3-2, 0-2 SEC)

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA TEAM NOTES

- Parker White connected on a 33-yard field goal with two seconds remaining in regulation to give South Carolina a 37-35 home win over Missouri on Saturday afternoon.
- Missouri converted a 57-yard field goal with 1:18 to play to go ahead 35-34 before Michael Scarnecchia capped his first career start by completing four passes for 54 yards on the Gamecocks' go-ahead drive.
- Missouri never trailed in the first half before a second half that saw five total lead changes.
- After the first half was played in mostly sunny/ partly cloudy weather conditions, most of the third quarter was played during a significant rain/ hail storm that persisted into the early stages of the fourth quarter.
- Play was halted at 3:44 p.m. for a lightning delay with 2:41 to play in the fourth quarter. Missouri had possession, trailing 34-32 at the time of the weather delay with a 1st and 20 and the ball at the South Carolina 48 yard-line. Play resumed at 5 p.m.
- Attendance at Williams-Brice Stadium was 73,393.
- Carolina has now won three straight over the Tigers and is 5-2 against them since Missouri joined the SEC.
- South Carolina captains for the game were # 1 Deebo Samuel, #35 Daniel Fennell, #72 Donell Stanley and #87 Kiel Pollard.
- QB Michael Scarnecchia, TE Kiel Pollard and WR Josh Vann made their first career starts for the Gamecocks.
- TE Kyle Markway made his first start since 2015 for Carolina.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

- Michael Scarnecchia finished 20-of-35 passing for 249 yards and three touchdowns in his first career start for the Gamecocks.
- Bryan Edwards tied a career high with two touchdown receptions after pacing the Gamecocks in receiving with seven receptions for 73 yards. Edwards brought in a 12-yard pass from Scarnecchia on the Gamecocks final offensive series which was the final offensive play for South Carolina before White's game-winning field goal.
- Deebo Samuel surpassed Brian Bennett for sole possession of 13th all-time in career receptions in South Carolina school history and tied his career-high with his third touchdown catch of the season.
- In his first start for Carolina since 2015, TE Kyle Markway had a 27-yard reception deep into Missouri territory on the final offensive series for the Gamecocks' to help set up Parker White's game-winning field goal.
- Ty'son Williams set a new career-high with 15 rushing attempts for 51 yards.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES

- Byson Allen-Williams tied career high marks with 3.0 tackles for loss and one sack.
- Steven Montac finished with tied a career high with nine total tackles.
- Sherrod Greene's third-quarter pick six was his first career interception and the Gamecocks first defensive touchdown of the season.
- Jamyest Williams picked off Missouri's Drew Lock in the fourth quarter, his first of the season and third of his career.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Parker White tied a career-high with three made field goals including his go-ahead 33-yard attempt with two seconds remaining in regulation.
- White went a perfect 3-for-3 on field goal attempts, setting a new season-high in distance with a pair of 42-yard conversions. All three of his field goals came in clutch moments as his first attempt put the Gamecocks ahead 24-23 with 5:15 to play in the third quarter. The second attempt put Carolina on top 34-32 with 6:23 to play in the fourth quarter.
